A petition being filed signed by a majority of voters of school district asking the directors to call a special meeting to vote on school house site. Board ordered notices posted in accordance with the law.

Board of Director of school District 58 met at Lentner and decided to hire Miss Ethel Kipper to teach the fall and winter term of school of five months commencing the first Monday in September at a salary of 45 \$45.00 a month. Clerk ordered to draw warrents when monthly reports are filed.

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF LENTNER SCHOOL DISTRICT

Meeting called to order by J.H.Melson and on motion Frank Hall was chosen Chairman and T. W. Noel, secretary. On motion and sec. nominations for Directors to serve three years was decided in order. W. B. Todd and John F. Gerby were nominated, the ballots stood 27 for Todd and 16 for Gerby. Mr. Todd was declared elected. The next order of business to determine by ballot was length of school term in excess of eight months. No excess was voted. The next order of business to vote on bonds to the amount of \$1,500.00, fifteen hundred dollars, to erect a new school house. The vote stood 37 for the loan and 9 against the loan and it was ordered that the bonds be issued to build said new building. Motion and second that the school directors be empowered to dispose of old school house to the best advantage and the proceeds used in the erection of the new school building. On motion and second the board was instructed to issue bonds to run three years to build new school house.
